



**PARK WALK-THROUGH  
SUMMARY  
6-29-2010**

**The following is a list of parks discussed during the park walk-through on Tuesday, June 29<sup>th</sup> and the maintenance/improvement items discussed for each park. Please prepare for the meeting by prioritizing the list of items below that can be included in the 2011 budget. The cost for those items in bold are shown on the attached spreadsheet.**

**1. City Center Park**

- **Decorative trash receptacle**
- Replace bushes along Pam and Al's
- Trim trees along boardwalk
- New plantings around control box of sprinkler
- **Pet disposal system (mailbox)**

**2. Town Square (area diagonally across from City Center)**

- Redo hillside with black dirt/grass seed
- Remove pine trees with different landscaping
- Redo sign—possibly an electronic communication sign

**3. Old Mill Park**

- **Decorative trash receptacle**
- Rip rap around fishing pier (will complete this year)
- Redo around manhole
- **Add bench by trail**
- **Pet disposal system (mailbox)**

**4. Rapid Waters Park (with pergola)**

- **Decorative trash receptacle**
- Sod around cement (will complete this year)
- Clean out storm sewer outlet, change daylight area
- **Sign—plaque for Barfneckt donation**

**5. Evergreen Park**

- Bring fence closer to infield—convert field 1 to Little League Baseball?  
Check on softball use
- Redo drain tile because drainage from mobile home park is wrecking field 1—  
\$5-6,000 job



- Reconstruct players' benches at each field—convert to aluminum and add length. Staff has made contact with local contractor to find refurbished benches.
- Batting cage (Little League will be complete this year)

## **6. Grove Street Hockey Rink**

- **Decorative trash receptacle**
- Paint inside of warming house (Andrew Hatling will give staff names to paint this summer)
- Take down 2-story shed
- Replace nets and frames
- Hockey boards will be fixed by the manufacturer late July/early August

## **7. Highland Park**

- New playground structure (see attached master plan)--- set aside money in budget, cannot install new structure in 2011
- Paint grandstand, dugouts, buildings, shed—check with Lions Club to ask for help and find out what they own
- Bull pens
- Batters eye
- Fix fence
- New back-stop netting
- Put in two **bike racks**

## **8. Riverpointe Park**

- **Decorative trash receptacle**
- **Pet disposal system (mailbox)**
- Secure fishing blocks
- Clean up dead trees

## **9. Other parks**

- Community Park-future park sign with plan
- Park identification signage—the following parks do not have the park signs
  - (1) Ann Street
  - (2) Highland Park (2<sup>nd</sup> sign at the corner of Hutchinson and High Street)
  - (3) Kings Highlands
  - (4) Rapid Waters Park (memorial or historical plaque)
  - (5) Sunset Ridge Park (in Forest Hills)
- Rick-Johnson Park
  - Bike racks
  - Canoe rack
