

**MINUTES OF THE
WATERTOWN CITY COUNCIL
Canvass Board Meeting Tuesday, November 9, 2010**

1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, the canvass board meeting of the Watertown City Council was called to order, on **Tuesday, November 9, 2010** by Mayor K. J. McDonald at 6:25 PM in the Watertown City Hall Council Chambers.

Upon roll call the following Council Members were present: McDonald, Steven Duske, Dan Geiger, Earline King and Rick Mann.

The following staff members were present: City Clerk Steven Wallner.

2. CANVASS ELECTION RESULTS

A. Wallner presented the results of the General Election which was held Tuesday, November 2, 2010 for the purpose of electing a mayor for a two-year term expiring December 31, 2012; two council members each for a four-year term expiring December 31, 2014; and a special election for one council member for a two-year term expiring December 31, 2012. There were 1,647 votes cast in the election with the following results:
