



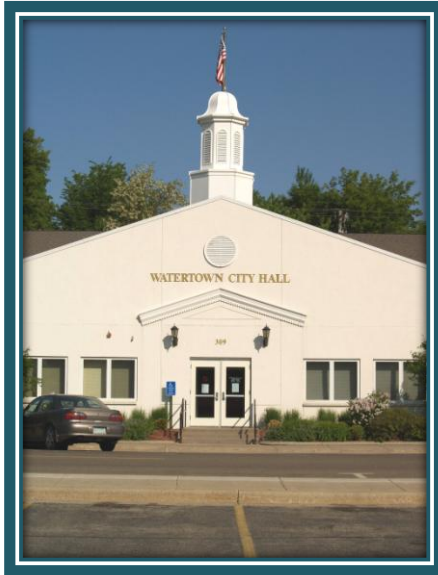

Subject: Watertown Vandalism



Over the past several days there have been numerous calls taken relating to vandalism of personal property in the City of Watertown. The vandals are smashing out vehicle windows. The property damage is accruing at a high rate ... what does that mean for the vandals? Potentially felony charges being assessed against them.

What initially starts out as misdemeanor acts can be aggregated to a felony charges when each instance is proven to be committed by the same actor(s).

In light of the ongoing incidents, CCSO will be taking a very aggressive stance on enforcing the Watertown Curfew Ordinance.

CCSO would also appreciate the following measures are taken by Watertown residents:

Please call CCSO,

- if you observe groups of juveniles out late at night
- if you see or hear any suspicious activity, especially late at night
- if you have any information relating to these or any crimes (see Contact info below).

Also to help avoid becoming a target, park vehicles in garages if possible, or park as far from the street as possible.

All children under 18 years of age must be off the streets by the following times, based on their age and the day of the week:

Age	Sunday – Thursday	Friday – Saturday
Younger than 12	Home by 9 p.m.	Home by 10 p.m.
12 - 14	Home by 10 p.m.	Home by 11 p.m.
15 – 17	Home by 11 p.m.	Home by midnight
